## You will complete a writing assignment for each of the TED talks that you chose.

- 1. State the title of the TED Talk you chose, the name of the presenter, the date it filmed and the length of the video.
- 2. Provide a bio of the presenter in your TED talk. You can find this information by clicking "Full Bio" on their video page. You should also do a Google search to learn more about the presenter.
- 3. Please explain why you chose this particular TED Talk.
- 4. Give a brief summary of the TED talk that focuses on the presenter's main point of the presentation.
- 5. What type of data/evidence/facts did the presenter use to support their point of view?
- 6. TED Talk presenters are known as effective public speakers. Describe two things this speaker does well in terms of engaging the audience.
- 7. Write about two specific things you learned from this presentation.
- 8. How could you apply the information from this TED Talk to your life?
- 9. If you could ask this speaker a question about his/her information or presentation, what would you ask?
- 10. Give one piece of constructive criticism that would improve the presentation.
- 11. What could you state to recommend this TED Talk to other psychology students? Explain.
